Allowance Standard (AS) Updates

Attachment 4 contains AS updates. Changes are the result of cataloging actions to replace Acquisition Advice Code “V” and “Y” NSNs and changes generated by the OPR. These changes are provided to update your WRM records. Remember to establish prime-sub relationships when applicable. Use the information in the “Add” and “Replaced” portion of the change document to determine the need for prime-sub relationships. If an NSN is replaced and there are on-hand balances, a prime-sub relationship should be established. Adjust WRM levels on NSNs listed as “Add” or “Delete.” If you have any

questions or concerns, contact the appropriate AS manager. A list of the AS managers and the current version of each AS is available on the AFMLO web site at <https://afml.ft-detrick.af.mil>. Only minor changes are contained in this attachment and no SORTS reporting option is required. Any SORTS reporting option required as a result of a major AS change will be provided in the Transition Plan coordinated between the Pilot Unit, MEFPAK, and HQ USAF/SGXR. Additionally, you may sign up to receive electronic notification of changes to AS maintained at your account. Tentage in Allowance Standard (AS) 902A

The following article was published in the February 2001 issue of the ACC Log Dog Newsletter. It addresses tentage issues in Allowance Standard (AS) 902A by providing the basic layout, definition of separate tent components, and a link to the DSCP base camp tentage web page. WRM Project IA-Patient Decontamination Package

Have you ever been confused about the seemingly incompatible tentage items on the WMDT Equipment Package on 902A? It's very easy to think the AS is wrong, when in fact there is a method to the madness.

The tentage on AS 902A is designed to create a six-section decontamination tent with three end walls in its structure, and a two-section equipment donning/doffing tent. The reason for the three end walls in the six-section tent is to help create a liquid splash barrier internal to the tent. The

donning/doffing tent is located several hundred feet away, near the vapor hazard line, to provide a place to change into or out of chemical protective gear. **Attachment 1** is Appendix A3 – Decon Facility Layout which gives the basic layout of the facility. It is excerpted from the 24 Jun 98 WMDT CONOPS, page 49.

Looking at the Allowance Standard (902A), the following stock numbers are listed:

8340011985358, FLY TENT DESERT TAN, UNIT OF ISSUE: EACH, QUANTITY: 4. This item meets the requirements of both tents. Each Fly is 32 feet wide, and is designed to cover two (2) sections of Temper Tent.

8340011987618, TENT SECTION, POLYESTER, UNIT OF ISSUE: EACH, QUANTITY: 5. This item meets the requirement of both tents. This stock number is for an END section. A total of five (5) end sections are needed. Three of these are for the six-section main decontamination tent, and two for the small donning/doffing tent near the Vapor Hazard Line. 8340012116788, DOOR TENT 27.83 IN WIDE, UNIT OF ISSUE: EACH, QUANTITY: 2. This item meets the requirements of the main decontamination tent. There are two doors on the main decontamination tent.

8340012136006, WINDOW TENT DUCK, TAN, UNIT OF ISSUE: EACH, QUANTITY: 8. This item meets the requirements of both tents. There are a total of eight window sections, six on the

main tent, and two on the small donning/doffing tent.

8340012388101, FRAME SECTION TENT, UNIT OF ISSUE: EACH, QUANTITY: 10. This item meets the requirements of both tents. There are a total of seven frame sections required for the six-section decontamination tent, and three required for the two-section donning/doffing tent. Note that there is a typographical error on page 49 of the CONOPS referenced above – a total of three frame packs are required for the donning/doffing tent, not two as referenced. The Color of Money

Yes, the simple answer to the color of money question is “green.” However, the phrase “color of money,” in our business, refers to the differences between appropriated funds. This is an easy way to describe a complex set of financial laws and regulations that govern the management of funds in the U.S. Government. It would take volumes to address every facet of financial management rules; however, the basic rules that color public money are not hard to understand. This article will provide a snapshot of some of the important rules to live by. The rules are the Anti-

Deficiency Act, Bona-Fide Need Rule, Election Rule, and Augmenting Appropriations rule.

Anti-Deficiency Act

This rule is simple. No agent of the government (that means you, your SQ/CC, your RMO, etc.) can obligate the government in excess of the amount that Congress appropriates in any particular appropriation. The two keys to this rule are obligating the government: 1) in excess of current appropriations and, 2) in advance of future appropriations. The idea is “pay as you go.” Don’t obligate the government for any products or services unless the money is in the “bank”--the “bank” being the particular appropriation.

Bona-Fide Needs Rule

The simple rule of thumb for this rule is that a requirement can be older than the money, but the money cannot be older than the requirement. The prime example is end-of-year spending. In order to spend 604 funds, you purchase \$150,000 worth of a pharmaceutical. Your annual usage on the item is \$50,000 per year. In essence, you are buying a 3-year supply of this item and the use of current FY funds for this purchase violates the bona-fide needs rule.

However, this rule does not prevent you from maintaining legitimate inventories at reasonable and historical levels. The “need” is being able to maintain the inventory level so as to avoid disruption of operations. The problem arises when the inventory crosses the line from reasonable to excessive (as in the example above). So be careful when expending those “efficiency funds” at the end of the fiscal year.

Election Rule

No, this does not involve dangling chads. Essentially, this rule states that once an agency decides to use a specific appropriation to fund a particular product or service, they cannot arbitrarily switch to another appropriation that could be used for the same purpose. For example, the PMI Program could be funded with WRM or O&M funds. The AFMS made the decision to fund PMI with O&M. Now that the decision has

been made, AFMS cannot arbitrarily change the funding to WRM. Once you make a decision, you must stick to it.

Augmenting Appropriations Rule

This rule states that an amount available under law may be withdrawn from one appropriation account and credited to another only when authorized by law. In a nutshell, you can’t arbitrarily take funds from one pot (DHP funds) and use them to purchase WRM materiel which is line funded. If an appropriation is insufficient to fund a project, you cannot use another appropriation to “augment” the other appropriation--unless authorized by law. (Comment: Applies across the board.)

So many rules, so little time. These are just a few of the rules that govern financial management of public funds. The rules are not there to keep you from accomplishing the mission; they are there to ensure you are a good steward of the public’s tax dollars. So the next time your boss tells you to “just get it done,” remember to avoid violating any of these rules. Additionally, violation of one rule usually results in the violation of others. Revision of AFMAN 23-110

A revision of AFMAN 23-110, Volume 5 has begun. A very aggressive timeline has been established and completion is expected in March 2002. Chapters will be reviewed and revised in groups with approximately one month allocated for the completion of each group. The complete schedule of revisions is at **Attachment 6**.

Hopefully, this schedule will expedite future revisions and their subsequent publication.

The revision of Chapters 6, 15, and 16 will begin on 2 April 2001. We anticipate submission for publication by 7 August 2001. We solicit your recommended changes, deletions, additions, and new business processes applicable to these chapters. Use AF Form 847, "Recommendation for Change of Publication" to submit your ideas and revisions.

We would also like your comments on a proposal to consolidate existing chapters into single related subject matter chapters. The chapters under consideration are listed in **Attachment 6**. Examples: What are the pros and cons of such a move? Are there any chapters on the list that should not be combined? Are there chapters on the list that should remain stand-alone? Are there other chapters that should be merged?

Many logistics personnel have expressed concerns about the deletion of several topics from AFMAN 23-110, Volume 5. Examples: Are there topics that should be reinserted in whole or in part to provide guidance to our personnel? As we move from MEDLOG to DMLSS, are there instructions in AFCSM 41-230, Volume 2 that should returned to AFMAN 23-110, Volume V?

In this role, ASHE will take the lead in coordinating the allocation of specific frequencies designated for medical telemetry equipment to assure interference does not occur, explained Dale Woodin, ASHE advocacy director.

Facilities Management

The Facility Sustainment Model (FSM) and Its Impact on Real Property Maintenance Activity Funding March 2001 Update

The Facility Sustainment Model (FSM) will be used to determine budgeting requirements for Sustainment PE ****78 (formerly Maintenance &

Repair). A “snapshot” of the Air Force Medical Service (AFMS) Facility Inventory contained in the C.E. Real Property Records will be run against industry developed cost factors to determine overall requirements. Remember, this is only for determining requirements; *what is finally received may differ.* Distribution of funds to the MAJCOMs will also be based on FSM data. The critical link for AFMS is to ensure the information contained in the Real Property Records is accurate. This can only be accomplished at base level by reviewing the records/updating changes with the Base Real Estate Office. Issues have been identified with C.E. Real Property Records concerning the inability of the Automated Civil Engineering System (ACES) to identify “funding source” for each building on record. Specifically, “who is supposed to pay” for the buildings’ sustainment. The current method is to use the Category Codes in the record. While this accounts for approximately 85 percent of the buildings (clinics, labs, hospitals) AFMS is responsible for, it doesn’t clearly identify shared buildings, storage, utility buildings, parking lots, etc. Efforts are underway to develop a standard code either in an existing field or creating a new field in the database to ensure ALL buildings maintained with Defense Health Program (DHP) funds can be easily identified. Each service currently will budget for Restoration & Modernization PE ****76 separately, but future Office of the Secretary of Defense plans for the FSM include the ability to develop requirements for this and determine Plant Replacement Value (PRV). New Safety Standards Postponed

Several federal safety policies have recently been delayed. Two federal regulations relevant to medical facility management include the Needlestick Safety and Prevention Act and a new Ergonomics Safety Act.

The Needlestick Safety and Prevention Act was formed in 1999/2000 and passed into law (H.R. 5178) in November 2000. The law was originally slated to go into effect on 18 April 2001, but has been postponed, with an estimated date of 18 June 2001. This act was developed to help reduce the number of bloodborne pathogen disease transmissions in medical facilities. Common pathogens transmitted through needlesticks are Hepatitis C (the most common type of bloodborne pathogen, which usually effects the liver), Hepatitis B, and HIV/AIDS.

The Needlestick Safety and Prevention Act also changes provisions within Federal Title 29 CFR 1910.1030, Bloodborne Pathogens. The definition of “Engineering Controls” is added in this standard. This involves having “safer medical devices” and “needleless systems.” Another major change to the standard is that facilities must address needlestick exposure reduction planning and provide proper documentation. Facilities must

update their plans to reduce or eliminate occupational exposures to needlesticks. They must also review their plans annually and implement them appropriately.

Record keeping changes are also included in the Bloodborne Pathogens standard. Incident records, at a minimum, must include the location or department where the incident occurred, a detailed explanation of how the incident occurred, the type of sharp involved, and the manufacturer of the sharp. The information collected and maintained in the logbook must be recorded in such a manner as to provide patient confidentiality.

The new Ergonomics Safety Act has been postponed because of heavy opposition by labor groups. Several groups have grievances pending in federal courts over this act. The entire proposed act has been sent back for review. No formal date has been set for closure.

Proponents of the Ergonomics Safety Act state it is not fundamentally solid enough to be a useful and effective tool. Many industries, including healthcare, have a vested interest in the outcome of the proposed act because of two main reasons: 1) the fact that the act is rigid and gives the employer very little opportunity for change; and 2) monetary impact. As the act is currently written, employers would have to invest a large amount of money for the implementation and sustainment of their ergonomics program. The act could contribute to many smaller businesses and companies folding and place an extra financial burden on the already strained healthcare community.


