## **Managing Your International Merchant Purchase Authorization Card (IMPAC) Program**

During inspections, an area that receives additional scrutiny is the International Merchant Purchase Authorization Card (IMPAC) program. That's because the potential for missteps or inefficient practices is significant. The causes lie with fairly liberal-purchasing standards, several IMPAC folders being indiscriminately maintained and pressure from customers for faster service.

Having reviewed several IMPAC folders, questions at times arise about the propriety of purchases. Is it really necessary to purchase higher cost cell phone holders because they "look better?" Why are several televisions ordered for offices that have no real need for them? Admittedly, such questionable purchases are rare, but every possible effort should be made to keep them under control.

IMPAC folder management is of concern. It is less than comforting to review IMPAC folders and discover they are maintained haphazardly. Disorganized folders reflect poorly on the

cardholder as well as the logistics office. Call numbers are more easily reconciled with invoices if your folders are organized.

(Note: I disagree with the above paragraph because IMPAC is a payment method, not a source of supply. We are now practically forced to use IMPAC to pay for orders less than \$2500. Thus, unless we can purchase the items through prime vendor, IMPAC is used to pay, even when we order using DBPAs.

Properly managing the IMPAC program can be tedious and at times frustrating, but doing so helps ensure that every purchase can withstand any level of review. Can yours? (HQ AFIA, Maj Linnes Chester, [Chesterl@kafb.saia.af.mil](mailto:Chesterl@kafb.saia.af.mil), DSN 246-2510)

## **DSCP/MILCARE Furniture Contract**

Air Force MTFs can now order clinical furniture off of the new DSCP/MILCARE contract ([SPO020099D8001](#)) below GSA prices. This central contract (through DSCP at 1.9 percent surcharge) will speed up the process of getting clinical workstation type furniture procured, designed, and installed. Although UNICOR waivers are required for clinical type furniture, individual MTFs will be able to save time by ordering off this existing contract, rather than completing the entire procurement process locally.

Representatives at UNICOR can be reached at 1-800-827-3168. UNICOR waiver requests can be faxed to 1 (606) 254-9048, or mailed to: P.O. Box 13640, Lexington, Kentucky 40583-3640. The turn-around time for evaluation by UNICOR is 7-10 days. Justification for waivers include delivery time of required items and requests for clinical furniture systems not produced by UNICOR.

After receiving a UNICOR waiver, MTFs can order through the DSCP/MILCARE contract. These orders will be placed through DSCP using MILSTRIP requisition packages (DD Forms 1348-6 with descriptive data attached). Furniture design, installation, and removal are also available through this contract. When purchased alone, services like

these should be O&M funded, (use fund code 2X in the MILSTRIP line, and complete the certified fund cite in the remarks section). O&M funded requirements should not be run through MEDLOG.
