MEDICAL MATERIEL

Web-Based Enhancement to the Air Force Medical Excess Distribution System (AFMEDS)

AFMLO began 1 Feb 2000 to test the responsiveness of a web-based enhancement to AFMEDS. The improved system allows using activities to perform real time queries based on DoDAAC, NSN, disposition date, and also match reported excess to specific war reserve materiel (WRM) allowance standard (AS) requirements. You can download a query for AS matches to a text file for easy use and manipulation.

The letter outlining the new capabilities and the 75-day test period, along with a descriptive PowerPoint briefing with step-by-step instructions on how to use the enhanced AFMEDS system are contained in **Attachment 5**. This information is also available on the AFMLO home page at:

Update to AFMLL 02-99 Supply Items Needed for the I-Stat 210000 Clinical Analyzer

Last year the AFMLO purchased the I-Stat 210000 Clinical Analyzer for all air transportable hospital (ATH) locations. The buy was for NSN 6630-01-411-2405 and included the basic machine and an operations manual. It did not include additional supply items to make it fully functional. Each location is charged with the responsibility to procure the additional items to make the I-Stat fully functional. The list below identifies the items currently on the AS 896 (ATH) for use with the I-Stat Clinical Analyzer. These items are also included on all ASs that have the I-Stat Clinical Analyzer, to include the following assemblages: MFST (A), SP43 (A), SP 43 (B), AEF (AF), AEF (BC), and SP11 (A). Some of these items are dated, and may have deferred procurement codes. The software download kit needed to perform recurring quarterly updates was recently added to the AS.

New Pharmaceutical Prime Vendor (PV) Contracts Awarded for Central 1 and 2, Southwest Region

Beginning 1 Mar 00, Central 1 region medical facilities will have a new Pharmaceutical Prime Vendor (PV). These facilities include the Air Force Academy, Buckley Air National Guard, Cannon, Davis-Monthan, F.E. Warren, Hill, Holloman, Kirtland, Luke, Malmstrom, McConnell, Mountain Home, Nellis, Offutt, Peterson and Whiteman. The primary and secondary Pharmaceutical PVs for Central 1 region will be Bindley Western Drug Company and Cardinal Health Inc., respectively. All affected bases should have received an invitation to attend the Post-Award Conference held on 15 Feb 00 at Nellis AFB, NV. Representatives from both companies and DSCP were present to discuss the new contract.

The contract for Central 2 region was re-awarded to Dakota Drug Inc., which begins 1 Mar 00. Ellsworth, Grand Forks, and Minot will maintain the same Pharmaceutical PV. There is no secondary Pharmaceutical PV for Central 2 region.

The Pharmaceutical PV contract for Southwest region was recently awarded to Bergen Brunswig Drug Company, with Cardinal Health as the Secondary PV. Bases affected include Altus, Barksdale, Brooks, Dyess, Fort Worth, Goodfellow, Kelly, Lackland, Laughlin, Little Rock, Randolph, Sheppard, Tinker and Vance. The contract start date is 1 Apr 00.

The following Pharmaceutical PV transition checklist is reprinted from the July 99 AFMLL to help facilities with changeover preparations:

Timeframe (# days prior to start date)	Item
60 days	Should be notified by DSCP of new PV award
60 days	Usage data should be forwarded to new PV from DSCP; make sure this action is

	completed. The earlier the PV gets your data the more prepared they will be
60 days	Plan for usage of all credits with current PV before the contract expires
30 days	DSCP should have contacted you with PV POC, scheduled training, conversion, etc.
30 days	Review translation table for accuracy. If possible have NDCs for all products vice PV item number. This will help with a smooth conversion by DMLSS
30 days	If buying off a regional DAPA vice the national DAPA, check with new PV to see if they have the product on their DAPA. If the new PV does not have the item, request it be added to their regional DAPA.
30 days	Make sure all PV master records have the MILSTRIP format for unit of issue instead of the current PV's unit of issue format (e.g., for package: PG instead of PK)
30 days	Start planning the completion of EDOs and drop shipments prior to start date of the new contract
NLT 30 days	Establish contact with new PV customer service representative
NLT 30 days	Establish contact with DSCP Case Manager
7-15 days	Training on new PV electronic order entry system and software
Last day	Process all PND receipts for previous PV materiel already received - don't forget drop shipment and EDO orders
