Shelf Life Extension Program (SLEP) Query

Airman Jones was preparing for an upcoming WRM inventory on all BW/CW projects at his base. During preparation, Airman Jones was discussing with his supervisor, Sergeant Smith, the frustration he felt with trying to get the current status of all items entered into the SLEP for his account. Sergeant Smith quickly remedied the situation with the answer to the following question: ***How can I find the current status of all items entered into the SLEP for my account?*** AFMLO has provided a web query to do just that! From AFMLO web site, select the "Procurement Team" link. From the Procurement Team, select the "SLEP Page" link and then select the "DOD/FDA Shelf Life Program Query" link. Here you will enter your SRAN, i.e., FM4804, in the DODAAC/SRAN box. Next hit the "Find Matching Items" button. The following link will take you directly there: <http://afml.ft-detrick.af.mil/afml/fom-p/SLEP/main.cfm>. Once the results come up, go all the way to the bottom of the list (it may be several pages) and hit the "List All" button. The results will be the complete details of all items in the SLEP program for your account. You can print the list from this screen. SrA Jones was amazed that just a few keystrokes could display complete status of all SLEP items for his account. Allowance Standards (AS) Updates

Attachment 4 contains AS updates. Changes are the result of cataloging actions to replace Acquisition Advice Code "V" and "Y" NSNs and changes generated by the Offices of Primary Responsibility. These changes are provided to update your WRM records. Remember to establish prime-substitute (P&S) relationships when applicable. Use the information in the "Add" and "Replaced" portion of the change document to determine the need for P&S relationships. If an NSN is replaced and you have on-hand balances, a P&S relationship should be established. Adjust WRM levels on NSNs listed as "Add" or "Delete." If you have any questions or concerns, contact the appropriate AS manager. The AS manager and the most current AS version can be found on the Air Force Medical Logistics Office (AFMLO) Home Page under the Medical Combat Support Operations Team option. Mandatory Procedures For All Services Contracting Actions

Many activities are now using the Veteran's Affairs Special Services (VASS) Contracting Office at AFMLO as the contracting activity for service contracts. MTFs seeking service contracts should review AFMAN 23-110, Vol 5, Chapter 16, section 16.17 for your responsibilities when seeking service contracts procurement through the VASS or the Base Contracting Office. All professional service contracts (medical), all Performance Work Statements (PWS), and Quality Assurance Surveillance Plans (QASP) must be reviewed and approved by HQ AFMSA/SGSLC prior to submission to a contracting office. Report Of Discrepancy Follow-Up

Standard Form 364, Report of Discrepancy (ROD) is used to document and report item or packaging discrepancies attributable to the shipper. If DSCP is the source of supply, there is the option of submitting the ROD online to DSCP from the AFMLO web site Procurement Team page, instead of mailing the ROD. If DSCP is not the source of supply, do not submit the ROD to DSCP. Refer to the DLA Customer Assistance Handbook, Thirteenth Edition 1999, Part IV (Federal Supply Class Assignments), or web site <http://www.supply.dla.mil/CustomerHandbook/index.htm> for the appropriate source of supply. Remember to print a hard copy of RODs submitted online should you need to follow up. AFMAN 23-110, Vol 5, para 9.6.6 requires follow-up on RODs if a reply is not received within 75 days. To follow up on a ROD, (1) follow guidance in para 9.6.6, (2) send an e-mail to medrods@dscp.dla.mil or, (3) fax a copy of the ROD to DSCP-MAMC, FAX: DSN 444-8005, commercial 215-737-8005. If a reply is not received by you within 15 days of follow-up, notify AFMLO. AFMLO/FOM-P is the POC for unresolved RODs (two follow-ups with no response). Eastman Kodak Awarded New Film Contract

Eastman Kodak (DBPA #SP0200-00-A-9013) has been awarded a new Medical and Dental X-ray film Federal Supply Schedule (FSS) contract by the Veterans Administration. This contract impacts ordering quantities under the current DBPA by changing the minimum film quantities from 1 to 5. The new FSS contract number is V797P-3782k and is in effect until 31 March 2005. Products formerly covered under FSS contracts V797P-3794j, V797P-3791j, and V797P-3740j are now included in this one new contract. One change from the previous FSS contracts is an adjustment in the minimum/multiples for the Special Item Numbers (SIN) V-1-1 Medical X-ray Film products and the SIN V-1-3 Mammography Film products. The minimum/multiples for these SINs have changed from 1/1 to 5/5 to reflect the commercial business practices of Eastman Kodak's Health Imaging Division.
