New Instructions for Updating the Air Force Medical Logistics Directory (Bluebook)

1. Browse to your organization's page in the Bluebook.
2. Click the 'Update' button at the bottom of the page.
3. Enter your name and email address (or phone number if you don't have an email address). This will be used only in the event we need to contact you if there is a question about the change.
4. Click the 'Next' button.
5. Your organization's address information will be displayed.
 - If your change is for organization information, such as address, make the change and click 'Submit Changes'. The change will be made and you will be returned to this same page for additional modifications.
 - If your change is for a position entry, scroll down to the personnel listing and click the name of the person you want to change.
 - To replace a person in a duty position, just update the name with the new person's name.
 - To remove a position, click 'DELETE this person'.
 - To change the order in which the positions are listed, modify the 'List Sequence Nbr' (The higher the number, the lower in the list they appear).
 - Click the 'Update' button.
 - When you have completed and reviewed all changes, click the 'Cancel' button under the address information.
 - Changes will be posted following review and approval by AFMLO/FOA staff.

Allowance Standard (AS) Updates

Attachment 4 contains AS updates. Changes are the result of cataloging actions to replace Acquisition Advice Code "V" and "Y" NSNs and changes generated by the Offices of Primary Responsibility. These changes are provided to update your WRM records. Remember to establish prime-substitute (P&S) relationships when applicable. Use the information in the "Add" and "Replaced" portion of the change document to determine the need for P&S relationships. If an NSN is replaced and you have on-hand balances, a P&S relationship should be established. Adjust WRM levels on NSNs listed as "Add" or "Delete." If you have any questions or concerns, contact the appropriate AS manager. The AS manager and the most current AS version can be found on the Air Force Medical Logistics Office (AFMLO) Home Page under the Medical Combat Support Operations

Team option. All changes contained in this attachment are minor changes and no SORTS reporting option is required. Any SORTS reporting option required as a result of a major AS change will be provided in the Transition Plan coordinated between the Pilot Unit, MEFPK, and HQ USAF/SGXR. War Reserve Materiel Balance and QA Records

War Reserve Materiel (WRM) balance records and WRM quality assurance (QA) records have no direct link in MEDLOG and are not dependent on each other to exist. MEDLOG will accept and maintain WRM balance records without QA records, as well as accepting and maintaining WRM QA level records without balance level records. Extreme care must be taken to maintain correct WRM balance and QA records during MEDLOG processing. The WRM Validation List is one of the primary tools used by Medical Logistics to identify and correct unmatched WRM balance, QA balance, and level records. The 'WVJ' transaction prompts MEDLOG to produce the WRM Validation List by detachment and project code. WRM balance/QA records and WRM balance level/QA level record imbalances are reflected on the WRM Validation List. We suggest you produce and work this list at least monthly to ensure WRM QA program validity.

Issue, loss, internal transfer, and condition change transactions against items in WRM projects account for the majority of unmatched QA records. When WRM balance records are created or deleted in MEDLOG, the corresponding QA records must be deleted or updated as required, with shipment transaction 'SHJ' being the exception to the rule.

Internal Transfers (ITT) of WRM assets between projects within the same detachment require deletion of old QA records and establishment of new QA records. Section information can be updated in QA records and no ITT action is required for balance records. Supply item QA records must be deleted when excess WRM assets are moved to inventory category 7 for reporting. Do not delete equipment or spare part QA records without Medical Maintenance coordination. The success of your WRM program is dependent on accurate QA records. Do the right thing! Mefloquine Rebates

If Mefloquine HCL Tablets, 250 mg, 25s (NSN 6505-01-315-1275) are part of your anti-malaria WRM program, manufacturer credit for expired or soon to expire product is possible. LaRoche Laboratories will give credit on the product up to one year past the expiration date. This is a great way to save WRM dollars. Product will have to be returned and your on-hand stock will be reduced. This will cause your readiness percentage to drop. Before contacting the manufacturer, call your command and ask if it's okay to do this.

Mandatory Use of DMLSS

The HQ USAF/SG memorandum (**Attachment 6**) mandates the use of the Defense Medical Logistics Standard Support (DMLSS) Automated Information System (AIS). All facilities with DMLSS Release 2.0x are required to use DMLSS as we progress toward Release 3.0 and, subsequently, consolidate all aspects of medical logistics into one standard system, enable theater interoperability between Services during contingencies, and turn off MEDLOG. This will afford individual MTFs the "look and feel" of DMLSS while reducing training time for Release 3.0 deployments and mitigating our risk associated with the AIS transition.

MTFs with DMLSS Release 2.0x on HP servers must use the following modules: System Services, Prime Vendor Interface, Facility Management, Customer Support, and Customer Area Inventory Management (CAIM).

MTFs with DMLSS Release 2.0x on NT or DG servers must use Systems Services and Prime Vendor Interface upon initial deployment. After

MTF logistics personnel receive module-specific DMLSS 2.0x training, these MTFs must also use Facility Management, Customer Support, and CAIM modules.

DMLSS Trouble Tickets On-Line Submission Update

DMLSS trouble tickets can now be submitted on-line by *DMLSS Systems Administrators*. This feature is accessible through the Tri-Service Medical Systems Support Center's (TMSSC) web site. Two user accounts are required for web ticket submissions. First time users will have to complete a simple on-line form to gain access to the web site (TMSSC InfoNet). Once access is obtained to the InfoNet, application must be made for a Remedy user account. Access is given to those requestors who are properly appointed DMLSS Systems Administrators.

New Allowance Standards (AS) Changes List Server

There is now an email List Server on the AFMLO AS web site, which will allow you to subscribe to AS changes. Once you subscribe, you will receive an email message providing change information on the Allowance Standards you have requested. These changes will still be published monthly in the AFMLL, but this will allow you to be proactive in maintaining Air Force Medical Service readiness capability.

The change notice provides:

- The specific AS changed.
- The AS Manager and phone number.
- All change information including NSN, Nomenclature, U/I, Qty, as well as critical item codes.
- In cases of deletions with replaced by, notifies when a prime/sub-relationship should be established.
- A web link to the specific AS to review all changes that have occurred within the last 30 days.

**New Medical/Surgical Prime Vendor
(PV) Generation II Contracts Awarded to
Global East, West, and Central Regions**

On 19 July 2000, DSCP awarded 6 Medical/Surgical Prime Vendor (PV) contracts to the Global East, Global West, and Global Central

Regions. These 3 global regions will replace the current 23 Med/Surg regions. Two PV contracts were awarded for each global region, 1 each to Allegiance Healthcare and Owens and Minor. Some changes with the Med/Surg Generation II contracts are the contract type. Previously Med/Surg contracts were a requirements type contract. Now they will be an Indefinite Quantity Contract. The performance period will change from 12-Month Base + 4 Option Years to 20-Month Base + 2 Option Periods. Another change is medical facilities were previously locked into the same PV for duration of the contract. Now a medical facility has the option to change its PV at the end of each period. A listing of the affected military facilities by DoD Region, with the transition date for the new contract, is broken down by global region and summarized below:

The following PV Transition Checklist is reprinted from the Procurement web site to help facilities with changeover preparations.

Prime Vendor Transition Checklist

Timeframe (# days prior to start date)	Item
60 days	Should be notified by DSCP of new PV award
60 days	Usage data should be forwarded to new PV from DSCP; make sure this action is completed. The earlier the PV gets your data the more prepared they will be
60 days	Plan for usage of all credits with current PV before the contract expires
30 days	DSCP should have contacted you with PV POC, scheduled training, conversion, etc.
30 days	Review translation table for accuracy
30 days	If buying off a regional DAPA vice the national DAPA, check with new PV to see if they have the product on their DAPA. If the new PV does not have the item, request it be added to their regional DAPA.
30 days	Make sure all PV master records have the MILSTRIP format for unit of issue instead of the current PVs unit of issue format (i.e. for package: PG instead of PK)
30 days	Start planning the completion of EDOs and drop shipments prior to start date of the new contract
NLT 30 days	Establish contact with new PV customer service representative
NLT 30 days	Establish contact with DSCP Case Manager
7-15 days	Training on new PV web-based ordering system
Last Day	Process all PND receipts for previous PV materiel already received—don't forget drop shipment and EDO orders
