### AFMEDS Update

AFMEDS is now available on the World Wide Web (WWW) at the following address:  
<http://www.medcom.amedd.army.mil/afmlo/afmeds.htm>. Separate options for using AFMEDS are provided for Air Force activities and other DoD activities.

Air Force activities may:

- 1) Review the Excess Available list. The availability of excess materiel to Air Force activities has been reduced to 30 days. Therefore, it is very important that requests for this materiel be submitted as quickly as possible.
- 2) Review new items of excess that have not been published in an AFMLL.
- 3) Download an AFMEDS Query System for use in reviewing and requesting excess materiel.

Other DoD activities may:

- 1) Review an Air Force list of available excess materiel.
- 2) Review a Humanitarian Assistance List of materiel.



- 3) Review the Navy Medical Excess List.

### **Table of Allowance (TA) Changes**

Changes to Tables of Allowance (TAs) occur for numerous reasons, for example, cataloging changes or mission requirements. Some of the best changes are suggested by users and managers of the assemblages who have hands-on experience and know what works and what does not. AFMAN 23-110, Vol 5, Chapter 6 provides guidance for recommending a TA change. AFMLO reviews and ensures item availability, sustainability, and supportability. After the National Stock Number (NSN) has been approved (Local Purchase items require NSN assignment) TA changes are made to the database, forwarded to Warner-Robins AFB for publication, and distributed to the field.

What if an NSN is in terminal status (AAC Y or V)? Check your other WRM projects and scan the AF Medical Excess Distribution System (AFMEDS) for excess. Potential substitute (consumables and supplies) items may be identified using the MEDCAT-X and FEDLOG query options. The Product Price Comparison tool can also be used, however, it will reflect only depot-stocked and Distribution and Pricing Agreement (DAPA) items. MEDCAT-X has the capability to run queries by nomenclature, part number, manufacturer, brand name, and descriptive words, as well as by NSN. If your clinical staff approves of the substitute, load it with a Prime Substitute Relationship (PRS) against the NSN currently on the TA. Replacing equipment items can create additional problems and should not be done without the Office of Primary Responsibilities (OPR) approval. With MEDCAT-X and FEDLOG available on CD-ROM, the capability to research has been greatly improved from the old microfiche days.

Substitute NSNs can be applied against prime AAC Y or V NSNs. However, the substitute NSN will not be reflected on the WRM Requirements List. MEDLOG only compares available balances and identifies a true shortage quantity on the Requirements List once substitute balances have been applied. To circumvent the ordering of these prime AAC V and Y items, it would be advisable to keep abreast of the number of AAC V and Y items within your WRM detachments and projects. The Prime/Substitute Relationship list is a useful tool for quickly verifying the relationship.

AFMLO is available for assistance if you encounter problems. AFMLO is working with the OPRs to identify and replace all terminal items. (AFMLO/FOCT, Kathy Murtagh, DSN 343-4183)

### **Reporting and Distribution of Report of Discrepancy (ROD)**

AFMAN 23-110, Volume 5, paragraphs 9.6.6 and 9.7, provides instructions for reporting and distribution of RODs. The original plus two copies of a ROD should be submitted to DPSC/MAMC. Medical Logistics activities do not have to submit a copy of the ROD to AFMLO. Follow-up should be accomplished if a reply has not been received within 75 days. Write "**FOLLOW-UP**" and the date in red in the top margin of the SF 364 and mail to DPSC, GSA, base contracting etc., (see AFMAN 23-110 Volume 5, Para 9.6.6). Contact AFMLO if a reply is not received within 15 days of follow-up to any Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) source of supply. AFMLO/FOMP is the point of contact for unresolved (two follow-ups with no response) RODs. (AFMLO/FOCT, Joyce Hope, DSN 343-4163)

## You Asked

**Q.** DFAS is requesting we put the “remit to” address in the ordering address block of the computer generated DD 1155. Is this acceptable?

**A.** Yes, as long as finance is aware of this requirement and the vendor is not requiring a hard copy of the DBPA. Remember, some of our vendors have multiple addresses. Ensure you verify the address and change the Establish/Revise Vendor (EVD) file, if necessary.

**Q.** I need to order a Contingen Implant Syringe (PN 651-005) from C.R. Bard, but could not place the order because I was required to provide a doctor’s name and pin number. Why?

**A.** This item is a treatment syringe and is a restrictive device by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Before the item can be ordered, the doctor must complete a home study course on Contingens or received prior training elsewhere. After completing the course, C.R. Bard will assign a pin number.
