Allowance Standard (AS) Updates

Attachment 4 contains AS updates. Changes are the result of cataloging actions to replace Acquisition Advice Code "V" and "Y" NSNs and changes generated by the OPR. These changes are provided to update your WRM records.

Remember to establish prime-sub relationships when applicable. Use the information in the "Add" and "Replaced" portion of the change document to determine the need for prime-sub relationships. If an NSN is replaced and there are on-hand balances, a prime-sub relationship should be established. Adjust WRM levels on NSNs listed as "Add" or "Delete." If you have any questions or concerns, contact the appropriate AS manager. A list of the AS managers and the current version of each AS is available on the AFMLO web site at: <http://afml.ft-detrick.af.mil/afmlo/index.htm> located under Medical Readiness. Only minor changes are contained in this attachment and no SORTS reporting option is required. Any SORTS reporting option required as a result of a major AS change will be provided in the Transition Plan coordinated between the Pilot Unit, MEFPAK, and HQ USAF/SGXR. Additionally, you may sign up on our AS Changes List Server to receive real-time notification of changes to AS that you maintain at your account. The 45th Medical Logistics Symposium is scheduled for 6-9 February 2001, at the Holiday Inn Riverwalk, San Antonio, TX. This year's theme is "Full Spectrum Logistics." Course topics will address resource saving opportunities, contingency operations and futuristic logistics operations. Hands-on and how-to guidance will be provided in a seminar atmosphere. The symposium is pending approval from HQ AETC. As a general rule, training quotas are limited to one per medical logistics activity. Medical Contract Administration Workshop

Contracted professional services are becoming more common in the Air Force Medical Service. Feedback from the Air Force Medical Service senior leadership conference and the managed care symposium indicates customers want contract administration training tailored to the users needs at their Medical Treatment Facility (MTF). The Medical Contract Administration Workshop is an effective way to deliver it.

The lack of basic contract knowledge can result in monetary damages to the government. Contracting issues and topics of importance to logistics personnel at the MTF will be reviewed at the workshop. Discussions will include how to work with the contracting office; regulations and their impact on the process; contracting for services; types of contracts, including personal and non-personal services contracts and the appropriate use of each type. The contents of each section of a contract will be explained, and we will discuss writing a performance work statement and quality assurance surveillance plan, and providing the appropriate oversight during contract execution. The workshop covers modifying an existing contract, enforcing the terms of a contract, and the A-76/Direct Conversion process.

The workshop is offered stateside on an "as needed" basis and is offered to PACAF and USAFE, respectively, every other year. A date for the PACAF workshop is being decided. Time and location of the next CONUS workshop is to be determined. The need and a date for this workshop will be decided by field interest.

2000 Outstanding Medical Logistics Activity Awards

The 2000 Medical Logistics Activity Award scoring criteria is based on the general guidelines of AFI 36-2856, *Medical Service Awards*, and the Malcolm Baldrige Award Criteria.

The Special Team award has been discontinued. However, this year there will be individual recognition awards. Nomination information for this new award is contained in the *Leadership and Human Resource Focus* sections of **Attachment 6**.

The narrative for the 2000 Medical Logistics Activity Award is limited to 1 page per category. The page format will be Times New Roman, font size 12, and 1-inch margins on all sides. The entire narrative and all supporting attachments must fit into a single 1-1/2 inch, 3ring binder. Do not submit audio or videotapes.

Make your narratives complete and factual. Scoring will be based on your narrative for each of the seven categories and the attachments will be used to support the information provided in the narratives.

The AFMSA "call" for nomination packages went out on 21 Sep 00, with a due date of 01 Dec 00. Remember to route your nomination
