Updates from the AFMLO Logistics Analysis Team

Use of IMPAC Card

When placing orders with the International Merchant Purchase Authorization Card (IMPAC), cardholders should direct the vendor to mail a copy of the invoice to Medical Logistics. Use it to verify: vendor did not add any type of tax, prices quoted are the best prices charged, prices are correct, and transportation costs are included in the item price. Discrepancies noted should be resolved with the vendor prior to receipt of the assets, thereby eliminating the need for transaction reversals. Invoices also aid with the end-of-month card statement reconciliation.

Processing Receipts

When processing receipts for expendability code 1 items, MEDLOG error message "**649 - PRICE EXCESSIVE FOR EXPENDABILITY CODE 1 ITEM**" is displayed if the unit price entered exceeds \$10,000. Accepting the cost as it shows requires the operator to press "Y" on the keyboard. Even with this safeguard many erroneous entries are posted each month. This error message was programmed into MEDLOG in an effort to prevent receipts from processing at these erroneous prices.

IMPAC Receipt Reversals

IMPAC receipt reversals must be coordinated with Defense Accounting Office (DAO). AFMLO/FOC-A can assist with this coordination if requested and will provide expert guidance on transaction reversals if required.

When processing IMPAC transactions in MEDLOG, the first position of the Purchase Order number (PO#) must be "I". Transactions with a PO# beginning with an "I", are routed to the Standard Materiel Accounting System (SMAS). IMPAC receipts from MEDLOG are processed through SMAS and are posted to GLA 20086, accounts payable - IMPAC payables, which is a suspense account.

Processing problems arise when IMPAC receipts are reversed to correct erroneous data entry.

MEDLOG does not have the ability to pass PO number information to DAO in receipt reversal transactions. As a result the reversal is posted to GLA 20085, accounts payable - operating supplies, commercial and non-governmental, decreasing it by the amount of the reversal. GLA 20086 still has the original IMPAC receipt amount posted and reprocessing the IMPAC receipt with corrected information to include the PO number will post to GLA 20086, essentially doubling the receipt amount in that account.

DAO does not have the ability to identify and correct the erroneous amounts posted to GLA 20085 and GLA 20086. The only solution at this time is for the Medical Logistics staff to contact DAO at least once during any month that IMPAC receipts are reversed and request adjustments of these accounts. GLA 20085 should be increased by the amount of the receipt reversal and GLA 20086 should be decreased by the amount of the receipt reversal. Since DAO does not maintain detail records for IMPAC purchases one adjustment prior to the end-of-month should be sufficient. DBPA Purchases for FY 99

The annual DBPA Survey published on the AFMLO home page has been completed with a 100% response. Twelve facilities reported zero usage against the DBPAs. DBPA purchases were approximately 30 million dollars lower than last FY reported usage. This decrease in DBPA purchases was probably due to local contracting offices increasing the credit card limit to \$25,000 per call or the limit of the Federal Supply Schedule, increased emphasis and usage of the IMPAC credit card, and increase in Prime Vendor Sales. The number of active DBPAs continues to decrease. A summary of the DBPA purchases for FY99 is listed below:
