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## MEDICAL MATERIEL

### Safe Medical Devices Act (SMDA) Update

The Defense Personnel Support Center (DPSC) reports that the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs (OASD[HA]) is communicating with the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) with the intent of keeping the current DoD Medical Quality Assurance procedures as they relate to complaints intact. All complaints should be handled as in the past; the individual activity submits an SF 380 to DPSC, and forwards an info copy to AFMLO. DPSC will prepare mandatory MedWatch forms centrally, and submit them to the FDA and/or the manufacturer, thus eliminating the need for individual activities to do so. The semi-annual report will also continue to be submitted centrally by DPSC for the entire Military Health Service System.

Ensure the following information is provided on the SF 380: NSN, contractor, manufacturer, contract or purchase order number, DoD requisition number, source of item (depot, prime vendor, local purchase, etc.), quantity suspended, quantity on-hand, fax number, and name and phone number of the person familiar with the complaint. Accurate completion of this information ensures the MedWatch form is properly prepared and the complaint is recorded in the DoD Customer/Depot Complaint System (CDCS). ### Did You Know?

There are two types of Federal Supply Schedules (FSSs); single award and multiple award. Single award schedules are contracts made with a single supplier; multiple award schedules cover contracts made with more than one supplier for comparable supplies and services. It is important to know what type of FSS you are using when placing a call against a DBPA. If you are using a single award schedule, you do not compare schedules because usually the item is available only from one supplier. On the other hand, when ordering from a multiple award schedule, you should review a variety of the schedules for that contract, and your order should be placed with the schedule contractor offering the lowest delivered price. Review at least three of the contracts. For orders of \$2,500 or less, you can place a call with the FSS contractor of your choice without competition. For orders over \$2,500, you must compete. Therefore, orders should be placed with the schedule contractor offering the lowest delivered price. If only one source is solicited, you must justify the absence of competition in your contract file. Use AF Form 3062 or a similar form to abstract (document) competition, or lack thereof. The listing at pages 17 through 39 of **Attachment 3** is an excerpt from the National Scope Federal Supply Schedule Program, published by General Services Administration (GSA) indicating if a schedule is a single award or multiple award. You can also get copies of any FSS from GSA, Centralized Mailing List Service (7 CAFL), P.O. Box 6477, Fort Worth TX 76115, telephone 817-334-5215, or fax 817-334-5227. You should have a copy of the FSS from which you are ordering. If you have access to the Internet, the address is: ken.cowan@gsa.gov. For more information on single award and multiple award schedules, read the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), Part 8.
