Pharmaceutical Savings

It's common knowledge that you can save money by purchasing generic "equivalent" drug products versus purchasing specific brand names. So, when buying brand name products, do you shop for therapeutic equivalents? Prices for equivalents can vary on Federal Supply Schedules (FSS) and Prime Vendor Distribution and Pricing Agreements (DAPA), depending on how much of a discount the manufacturer offers the Government. The examples below were submitted to AFMLO as Zero Overpricing Challenges. The product beclomethasone dipropionate is compared in its three different administrations. The discounts negotiated with the manufacturers, Glaxo and Schering, differ on the recently awarded contracts and resulted in a considerable difference in the unit price of one brand name product over its competitive equivalent.
